SUBJECT: An Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan – The Master Transportation Plan – Part 1, to delete 10<sup>th</sup> Road North as a through public street connection between North Highland Street and North Hudson Street.

**RECOMMENDATION: Defer to April 10, 1999 County Board meeting and March 29, 1999 Planning Commission meeting.**

DISCUSSION: The Department of Public Works is still evaluating the proposed vacation of 10<sup>th</sup> Road North with respect to the site plan proposed by the United States Postal Service (See attached report). Staff will evaluate round-the-block vehicular traffic circulation and the loss of 10<sup>th</sup> Road North as a connection between North Hudson Street and North Highland Street.
