SUBJECT: Amend Chapter 6 of the Arlington County Code to include employees of Constitutional Officers for the Live Where You Work Grant program.

C. M. RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt amendment to Chapter 6 of the Arlington County Code to be effective July 1, 2004.

ISSUE: None.

SUMMARY: During its 2004 General Assembly, the State authorized eligibility of employees of Constitutional Officers for housing assistance through an employee benefit program. The County proposes to extend eligibility for its Live Where You Work grant program to include employees of the Constitutional Officers.

BACKGROUND: In 2002, the General Assembly passed legislation giving authority to the County to provide housing assistance grants to employees of the County and the School Board. The initial legislation did not benefit employees of the Constitutional Officers.

DISCUSSION: During the 2004 General Assembly, the State amended its initial legislation to include employees of Constitutional Officers, and the County is proposing to extend eligibility to this class of employees.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact as the County is not increasing the number of grants available.
