In 1998, Arlington County joined a growing number of communities nationwide who were switching to Community Policing, a philosophy and practice that seeks to involve all concerned citizens in the safety and welfare of their community. The Arlington County Citizen's Police Academy is a product of this philosophy.

The Citizen's Police Academy was designed to create a better understanding and communication between citizens and the police through education. The intent of the Citizens' Police Academy is to make citizens aware of how the Arlington County Police Department operates and its role in the community. Citizens of Arlington County are given an opportunity to increase their understanding of how police officers are trained and to experience the actual working environment of a police officer.

The Citizen's Police Academy is a two-way education process. Academy participants, who often have had limited exposure to the inner workings of a Police Department, will now be presented with the opportunity to voice their concerns and questions about how the Arlington County Police Department functions. The Department will have an opportunity to get an understanding of how citizens feel about their Police Department.

The Police Department's 21st Citizen's Police Academy (CPA) will start on September 7, 2017. The CPA will consist of 12 sessions that will meet on Thursdays, from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., at police headquarters, 1425 North Courthouse Road, Arlington, Virginia. This location is accessible from the Courthouse Metro stop on the Orange line. There is also the possibility that one session will meet on a Saturday at an off-site location.

Topics that will be covered in the Citizen's Police Academy include: police hiring, legal considerations, use of force, vehicle operations, community engagement, K9, SWAT, mental health crisis intervention and others.

Please have your application submitted no later than July 7th to be considered for the Citizen's Police Academy.
