

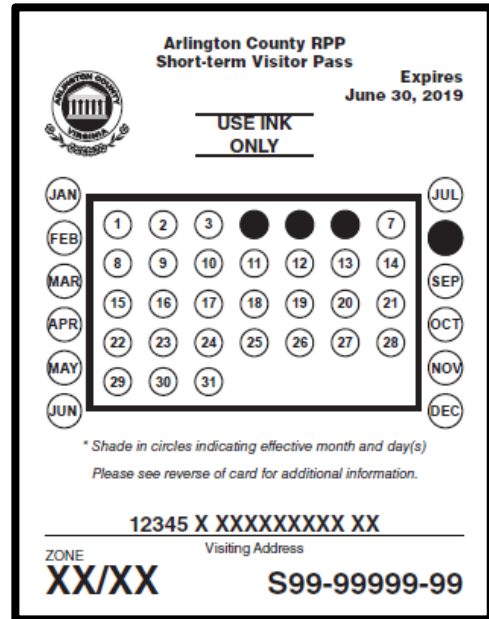
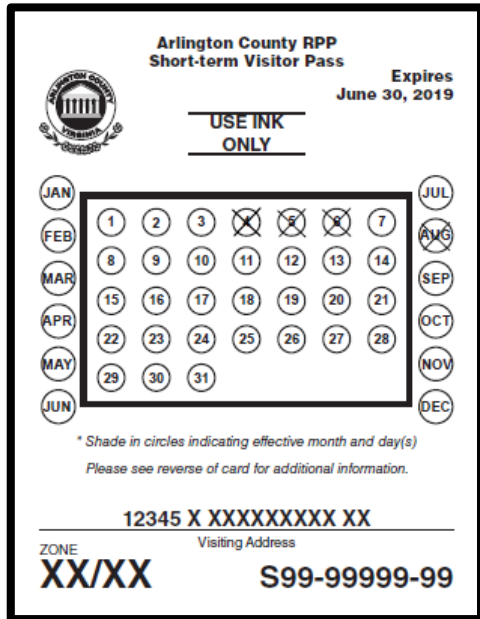

Dear Resident,

This new fiscal year the look of Short-term Visitor passes has changed. The focus of these changes is to make it easy to use and easy to enforce. Circles with months and days have been reintroduced in the short-term visitor passes and the hang-tag feature has been removed. For the pass to be valid please shade in circles indicating effective month and day(s). **Starting July 1, 2019 all Short-term Visitor Passes must be displayed in clear view on the dashboard only.** The new design will contribute to a better enforcement of the Residential Permit Parking Program by the Arlington County Police Department.

We have clarified the [Residential Permit Parking Program Replacement Policy](#) to cover most of the cases in which residents would need replacement permits. We will begin enforcing fees when residents do not submit supporting proof for damaged permits. We will also begin enforcing the replacement fee of \$20 for sold or traded vehicles.

The parking fee for vehicle specific permits is prorated if you apply on or after January 1st.
