

# Federal Capital Improvement Project

**Location:**

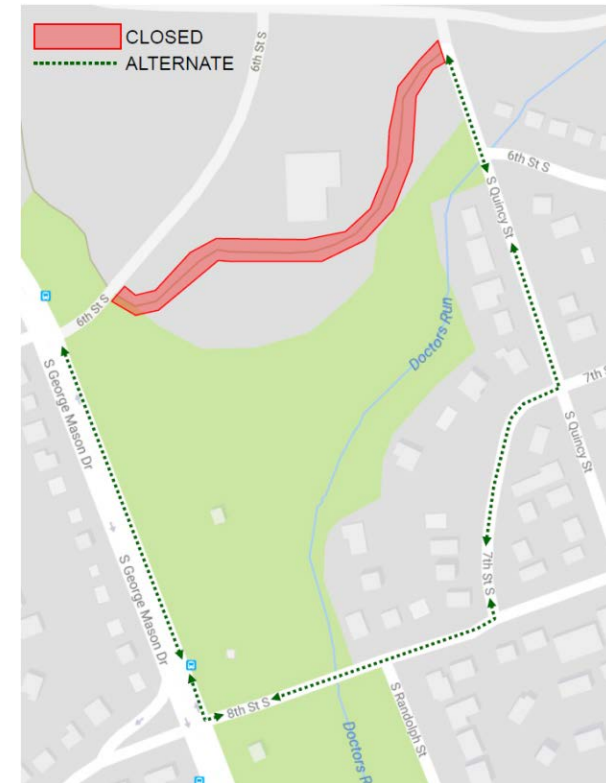
The campus is located near U.S. Route 50/Arlington Boulevard and George Mason Drive in Arlington, Virginia. The project is located on the south end of the site.

**Status:**

Phase I of the construction, rerouting the building access and mobilization, commenced October 4, 2017 and Phase II construction shall began November 13, 2017. The existing facilities shall remain fully operational during the construction. The project shall be completed October, 2018 and the work hours are typically 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. weekdays.

**About the Project:**

The U.S. Department of State (DoS) has identified a need to expand its facilities at the George P. Shultz National Foreign Affairs Training Center (NFATC). This center is the headquarters for the Foreign Service Institute (FSI). This expansion project is located entirely on federal property at the site of the NFATC.

**Current Update:**

Due to planned construction projects at the NFATC and security concerns effective immediately the walking trail will be closed, as outlined in the recently approved 2016 Master Plan,. The pedestrian trail shall close November 13, 2017. Signs regarding this closure are posted along the trail.
