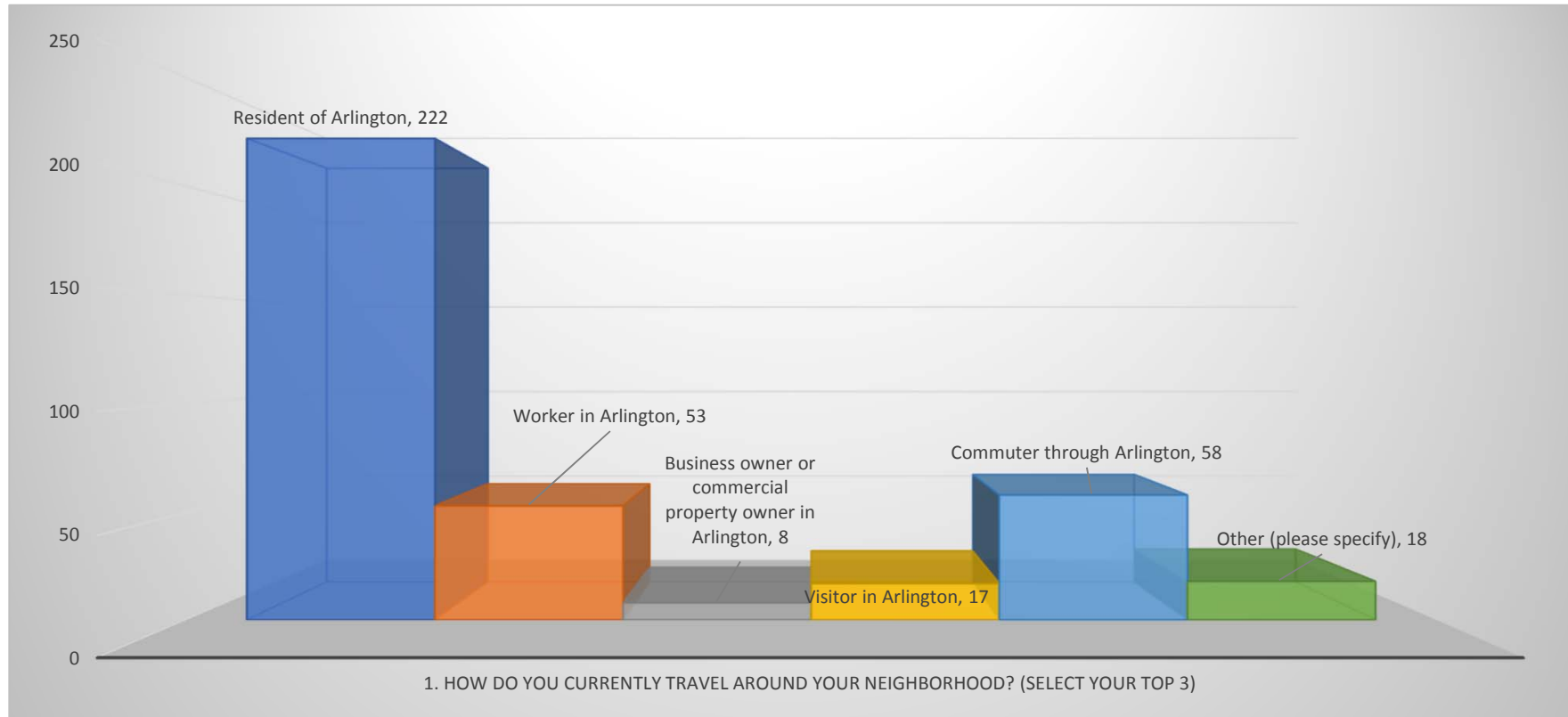


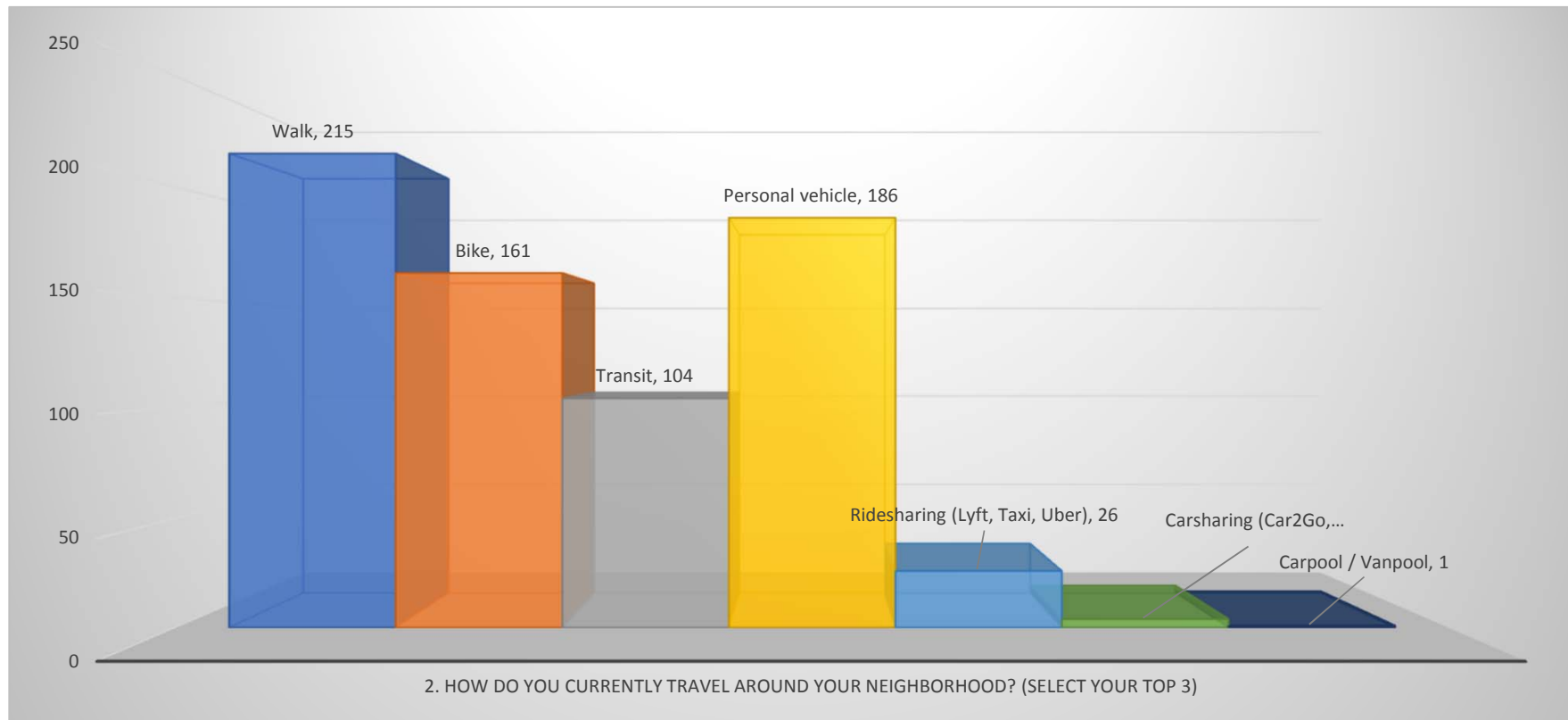
1. How do you currently travel around your neighborhood? (Select your top 3)

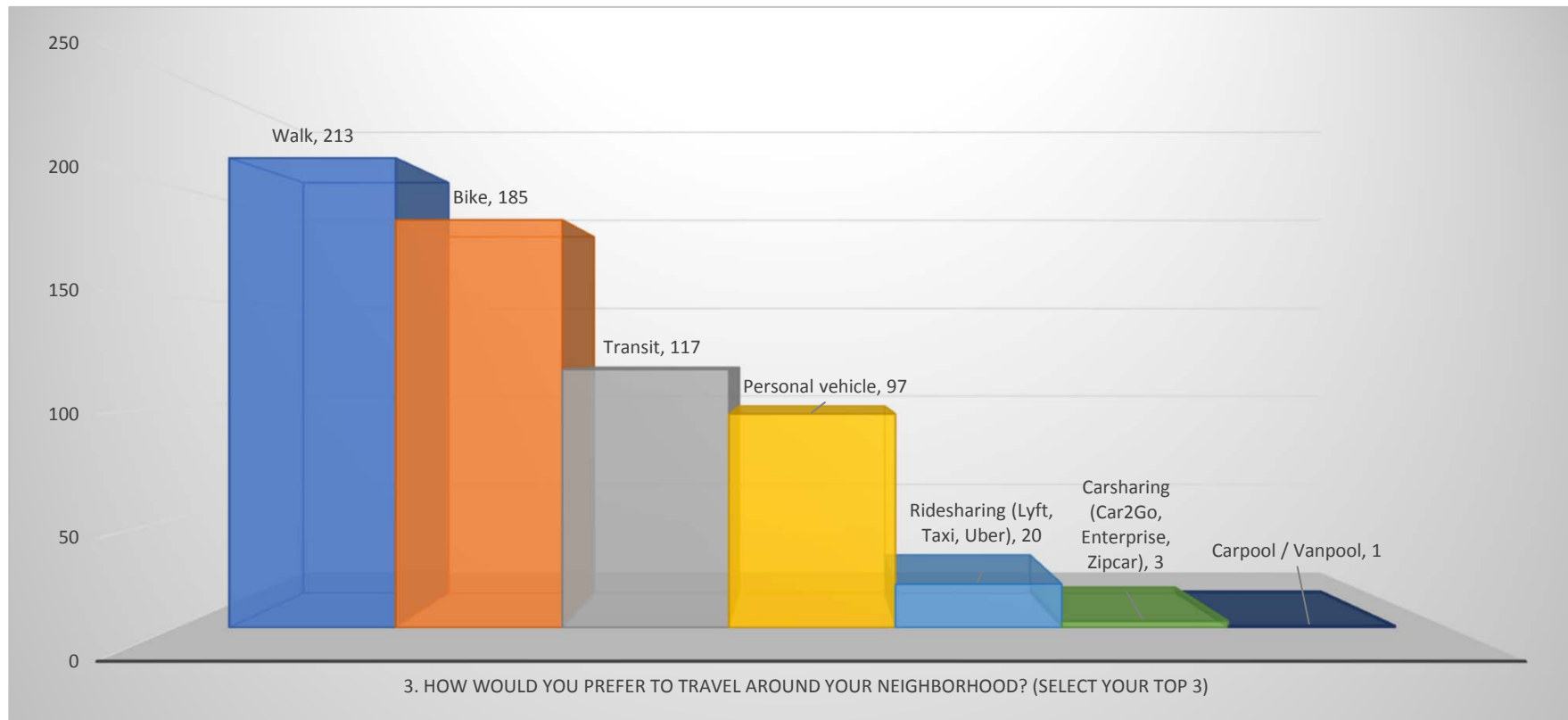

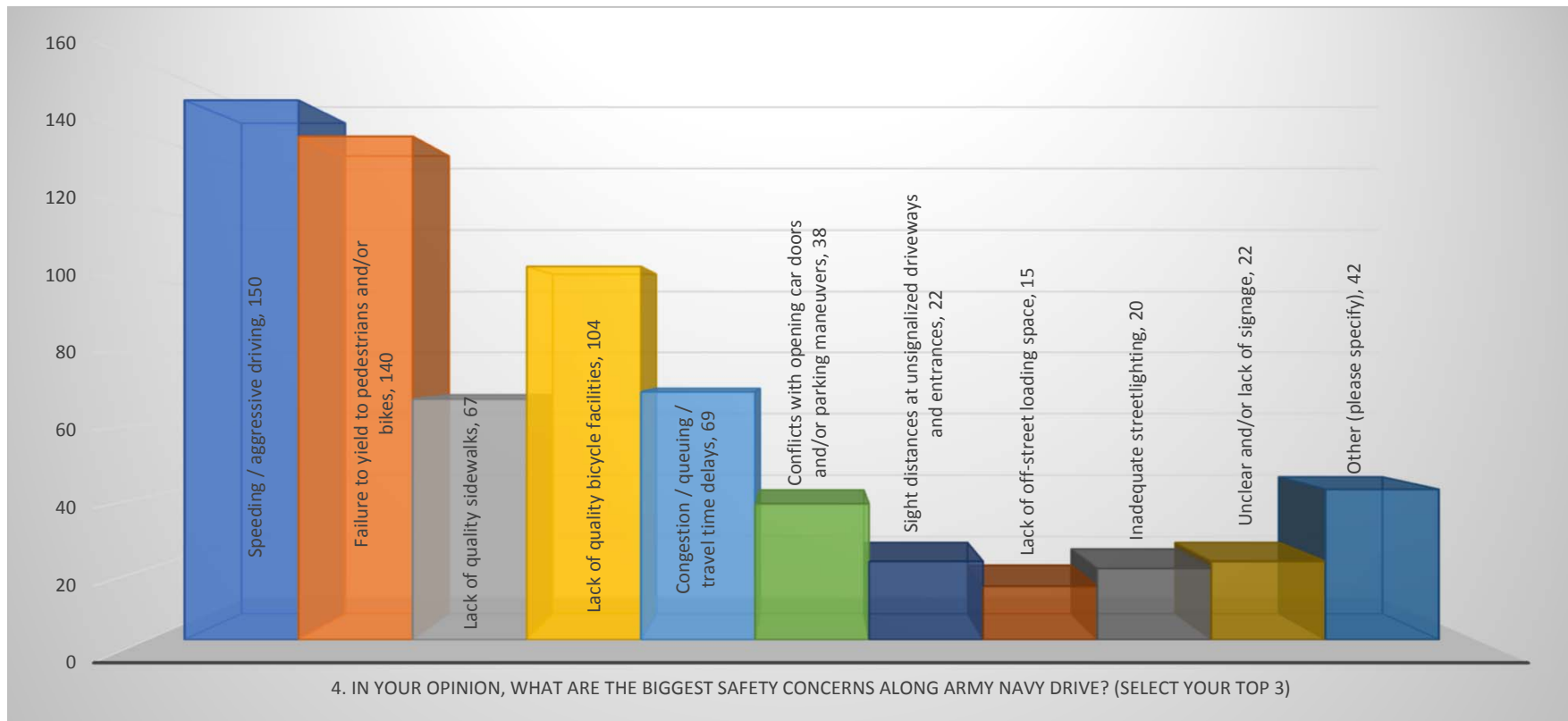

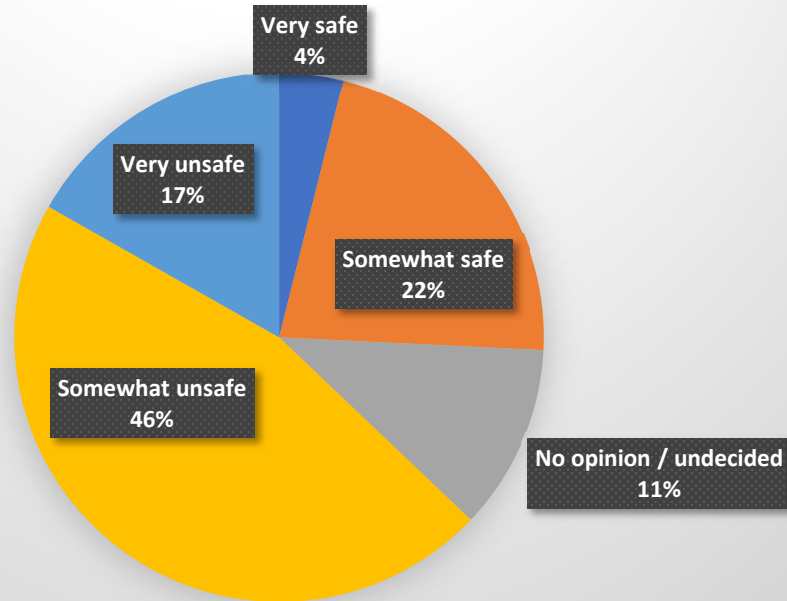

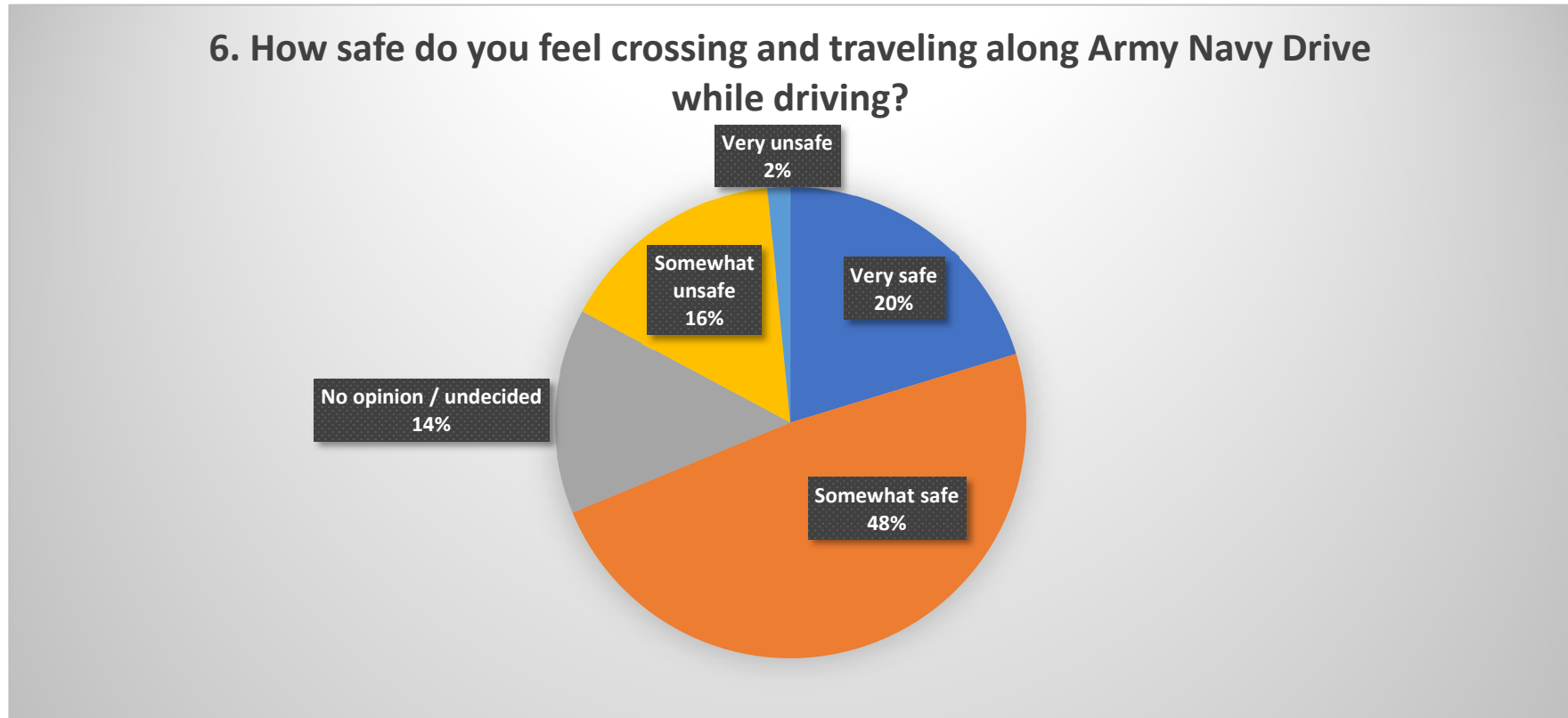

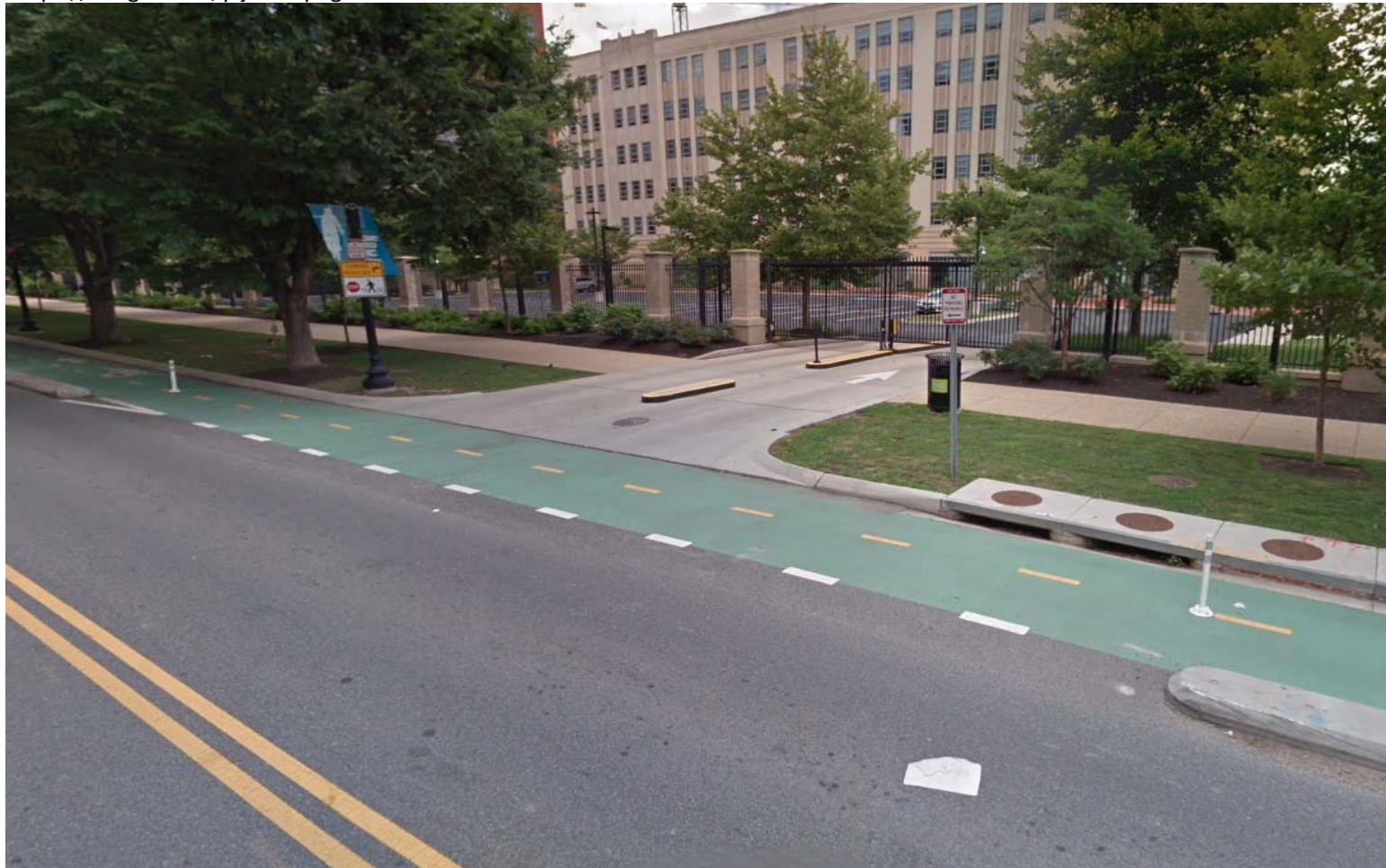

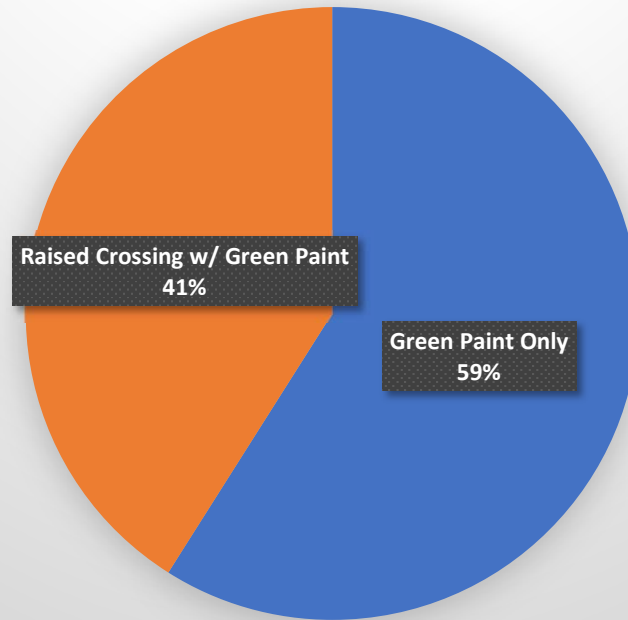
