**America Recycles Day (ARD)** is a nationally-recognized day dedicated to encouraging people to recycle and buy recycled products. ARD was started by the nonprofit organization National Recycling Coalition in 1997 and is celebrated annually on November 15. On and around this day thousands of local organizers coordinate events to educate and motivate people to join the movement to create a better natural environment.

Here are a few ways to celebrate America Recycles Day:

-  Take the pledge to recycle at [americarecyclesday.org](http://americarecyclesday.org) and tell others to do the same.
-  Learn more about recycling. Visit [epa.gov/recycle](http://epa.gov/recycle) to start.
-  Expand your recycling efforts. For example, if you already recycle in the kitchen add a recycle bin to your bathroom.
-  Organize or participate in an event. ARD events range from neighborhood clean-ups and information fairs to collection events for electronics and other hard to recycle items.
